**Attendance:** Chief Mikolajczyk called the meeting to order @ 1145; 10 members in attendance.

**Minutes:** Chief Mikolajczyk provided May's meeting minutes for review. (**Approved**)

**Treasurer's Report:** Copies of the report were provided for review. (**Approved**)

Chief Strobel gave out the first samples of the new Chiefs' Group business cards. These will be available for dues paid members.

### **New Business:**

Group entertained a motion to switch from issuing Savings Bonds to issuing AAFEs gift cards to award recipients, due to the large amounts of data required to issue government bonds. The amount of the gift cards would equal the purchase price of the bonds. (**Approved**)

Motion was made to provide \$50.00 donation per quarter to support the Airmen Against Drunk Driving organization. (**Approved**)

Motion was introduced to provide some -FTAC Classes with sponsorship of food such as pizzas as part of their certificate ceremonies. Chief Mikolajczyk will investigate the frequency required and cost estimates so it can be factored in to the budget. (**Open**)

Motion was introduced to have the Chiefs' group be one of the conduits allowing the local area town sponsorship/support for dorms on base. Several members have seen this at previous assignments and there were additional questions asked as to the nature of the role of the Chiefs' Group in this effort. This was tabled pending further research. (**Open**)

Chiefs' Group was solicited for funds to support the E6/E7 promotion party on the 26 of June. Members indicated that the Top 3 normally up-front sponsors this function, and the First Sergeants normally retrieve the funds from the TSgt/MSgt Selectees. Chiefs group will contact the Top 3 to verify past practices. (**Open**)

Issue was raised as to which agency controlled the Chief Suites on base and whether or not the Chief memorabilia is still present. It was determined the Chief suites are still available and memorabilia is still present in the suites. We will verify the controlling agencies. (**Open**)

Chief (sel) Lake noted that we owed Stahl High school \$50.00 but wasn't sure of the POC to move the funds to. POC is SMSgt (retired) Gail Ricker. (Closed)

Issue was raised for awareness of the upcoming AFSA convention in March 2009. They would e forwarding request for sponsorship in advance. (Open)

Chief Mikolajczyk brought forward that the Legal Office has recommended we not formally endorse the Heritage Trust Credit Union to move on base. (Closed)
