SUBJECT: Meeting minutes 21 August 2008

Attendance: Chief Mikolajczyk called the meeting to order. 18 members in attendance

Minutes: July meeting minutes provided for review. (**Approved**)

Treasurer's Report: (C)MSgt Lake provided a copy of the report for review. He discussed that the purchase of the 1st Quarter Awards winners' Savings Bonds was still waiting personal information needed for the bonds, working with Chief Hairston for that information. Also, 2d Quarter winners' AAFES gift cards hadn't yet been purchased. (**Approved**)

Old Business:

Identify/Review List of New and Departing Chiefs: Chief Abraham's retirement ceremony is scheduled on 22 August, 2008, at 1300, in Bldg 60. He will be receiving a Chiefs' Group brick from the Enlisted Heritage Hall. This is Chief Mikolajczyk's last meeting, and she was presented with a certificate of appreciation from the Chiefs' Group. Chief Schupp announced his retirement, as of 1 October, 2008. His ceremony is scheduled for 26 September, 2008.

Coins: Coins are running low, and redesign was mentioned, but no discussion ensued. (Open)

New Business:

- Chief Mikolajczyk turned over the Presidency of the Chiefs' Group to Chief Woodside, in accordance with the constitution, finishing out the year until January elections.

(Approved/Closed)

- Airman's Center rooms discussion was reopened (discussed at June Chiefs' Group meeting.) Members reopened discussion and wanted further explanation of the event. Chief Belcer explained the concept of sponsorship of each of the four rooms and the fundraiser by off-base agencies. Downtown Charleston restaurants want to hold a "Taste of Charleston" event for Chefs to show off their talents. Tickets would be purchased for approximately \$125, and food would be served in/near aircraft. There would be a need for volunteers to serve food, but no Chiefs' Group committee/labor required. Funds raised would be funneled through the Chiefs' Group to pay for improvements/upgrades to each Airman Center room. A motion was made to approve the fundraiser, pending final review/approval by the JAG. Motion was passed by a vote of 11 for, 7 abstained, no votes 0. (Open, pending JA review)

- Chief Futrell requested support for a donation of \$250 for tax for an Order of the Sword (AFRES). The Honoree was selected as an Honorary Chief in 1999 and donated the truck/equipment for the C-17 model at Charleston. Donation is needed by 15 Sepr. Motion to

approve was accepted for the total cost, pending reimbursement by other Pos. Yes – 12, all others abstained. (Approved/Closed)

- Chiefs' Fish Fry_- Chief Clemons confirmed that 3 October was selected for the Fish Fry. Chief Mik confirmed using the spring deposit for this reservation at ODR. Chief Clemons will confirm date (pavilion available as of 26 Aug 08). Tickets will be available at the next meeting. (approved/Open)
